

GAMES ROAD TOUR 10

Australians Sandra Fung and Ken Smith carried off gold medals in their grades in the Masters Games three-day road cycle tour which attracted 80 starters.

Fung, a 52-year-old from Burleigh Heads, won her division ahead of Hamilton's Elisabeth Langley-Cornille and was third fastest woman rider behind Rita Quill (Wellington) who took the 35-39 age group and Tina Wilkes (Paekakariki), the 45-49 division champion.

Smith, aged 67, from Southport, took gold in the men's 65-69 grade ahead of former Wanganui track runner Mike Shingles.

Aucklander Bruce Roberts was the fastest overall rider and also claimed the 40-44 division ahead of Marcel Hollenstein (PN) and Lyle Reilly (Auckland) who were second and third overall

Other men's group winners were Shane Clapperton (Gisborne), Peter Kane and Peter Dickinson (Wellington), Wayne Hudson and Lyall Reilly (Auckland) with Laurence Sunde Wanganui's sole victor.

In the women Kim Paxton (PN), Francis Rowland and Margaret Scholes (Gisborne) won age group titles.
